Israel Studies with Leehee Kanne: In this year-long class which will focus on Israeli culture, you will learn about famous people in Israel's past and present. This will include many of the important Jewish figures who were influential in the development of the state of Israel as well as current actors, musicians, and other people in pop-culture. In addition, you will learn about and discuss current Israeli music and movies.

Jewish Identity with Steve Kroser. Begin to explore the question; "What does it mean to be a Jewish teenager in America today?" This four section course will lead you to a greater understanding of family relationships in the Bible, the way various religions view the story of Abraham, as well as differences and similarities between various sects of Judaism...all in search of a better understanding of your own Jewish identity!
