We are now accepting registrations for the first year of the Florence Melton Adult Mini-School classes that begin the week of September 18th, 2011. The curriculum for year one includes **Rhythms of Jewish Living**, a comprehensive review of holidays and life cycle events in Jewish life and the **Purposes of Jewish Living**, in which Rabbinic and contemporary texts are examined for insights into theological issues such as revelation, creation and leadership.

First Year classes will be held on Sunday mornings at Temple Sinai at 9:45 AM; or Monday evenings at the Agency for Jewish Learning at 7:00 PM.

The Melton class fee for the year is \$575 plus a \$36 book which covers 30 weeks of classes. Once the deposit is established, you may complete your payments throughout the school year.
